This project was worked on by Mark Smith, Lloyd Binder, Jerry Duckworth and Tony Sandoval. It started out as just a truck bed conversion - but morphed into a "can you make it run and drive?" project. About \$2000 has gone into the total project, with about \$1000 of it donated, plus about a hundred hours of volunteer labor. Mark and Lloyd got it running at 4pm on Friday the day before the Mardi Gras parade. Mark learned to drive it at 5pm - and it



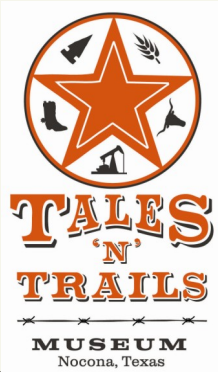
was in the parade the next day.
